Accessibility Information

To access the building there are steps with a handrail at the front entrance and a ramp at the left side of the building. The ramp can be accessed via a cobbled alleyway. Please ring the doorbell and a member of staff will answer. The Rake's Front of House facilities are all one-level and there is a row of accessible seating at the front of the theatre space.

The Round theatre can be accessed from the street. There are accessible toilets near both theatre spaces.

We have personal receivers available to amplify sound from infrared sound systems for hard of hearing audience members. These can be used with or without a hearing aid.

Guide dogs are welcome and fresh drinking water is always available for them.

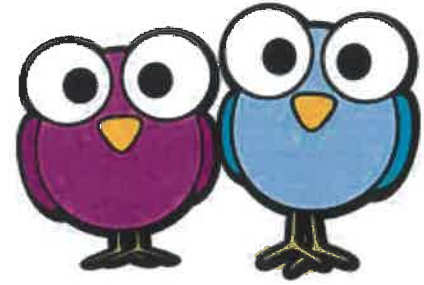
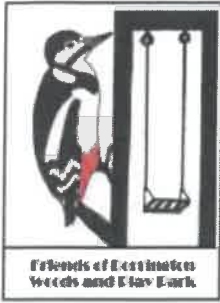
